

LA VUELTA (Tour of Spain)



Welcome to the “Vuelta a España”, your chance to cycle a tour like the professionals do! We will cycle passed deep canyons and ravines, along very narrow roads through forests. There are three «trick» stages during our Vuelta. We will see two of the most peculiar mountains of the world, pass through 3 countries and ascent the most mythical mountain passes of the Vuelta and we will eat plenty of very good food!

PROGRAMME

Day 1. Arrival

Sant Feliu de Codines- Sant Miquel del Fai-Santa Eugènia de Berga

Distance : 43km 600mts up

Arrival and transfer to Sant Feliu de Codines. We will cycle along the Little Canyon until we arrive at Sant Miquel del fai, from where we cycle via narrow roads to the valley of Vic

Day 2. Santa Eugènia de Berga – Sau – Perafita - Borredà

Distance : 72km / 1200 mts up.

We depart at Mas Albareda towards the lake of Sau via stunning roads through dense forests until we arrive at the ravine and our first «surprise». We enjoy spectacular views from the Sau Parador and continue via stunning roads until we arrive at Perafita, famous for its desserts. We can have a delicious rice dish before arriving at our destination.

**Day 3. Borredà – La Creueta – Puigcerdà**

Distance: 73km / 1800mts up

We depart from Borredà and find our second «surprise» at Saint Jaume de Frontanyà, a typical Vuelta climb. After a short descent we have our first mythical mountain pass, the Creueta, which takes us to 2000 mts, in the heart of the Pyrenees. La Creueta from La Pobla de Lillet is one of the finest cycling climbs in the Catalonia region. It is a long and fairly gentle climb through beautiful scenery, around the edge of the Puigllancada mountain. A large descent until Puigcerdà, a strategical village in the Vuelta and Tour. Optional: extra ascent after the stage.

Day 4. Puigcerdà – Andorra – Envalira – Canillo - Barcelona

Distance: 55km / 1650mts up

We cycle out of Puigcerdà and start to climb our longest and most famous ascent, the Envalira, which takes us into France and Andorra, at 2405 metres high! We have a beautiful descent into Canillo and then time to recover a bit. Andorra is great for shopping and for those who feel like it, an optional climb. In the afternoon, transfer to Barcelona.

Day 5. Free day Barcelona and Departure
